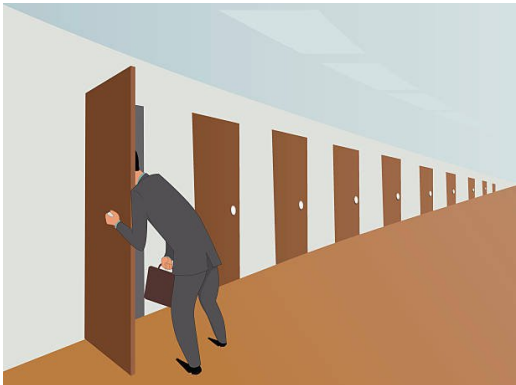


VISION KERALA - 2030

CURRENT SCENARIO

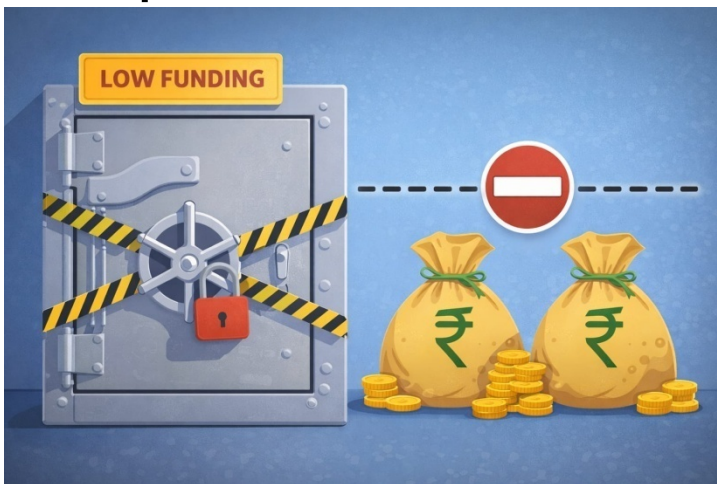
- Transparent and business-friendly policies, Strong government support for entrepreneurs
